### PRIDE NETWORK LEAD New results for the creation of the professional profile

A new phase of the ERASMUS + PRIDE NETWORK LEAD project has just been completed.

Diverse results were created by the international partnership, with the aim of training and supporting the Pride Network Leader.

Specifically, the materials are:

- <u>Development Programme and Trainer's Handbook</u> A training programme containing all the materials to develop a training course based on the standard professional competences of the future Pride Network Leader.
- <u>Handbook</u> A manual aimed at facilitating the start-up of the new Pride Network Leader role by supporting them in the organisation of their activities.
- <u>Toolbox</u> To provide know-how, tools and practical solutions to effectively perform the new role.

#### The testing phase and local events

All project partners tested the materials produced with local experts. In the testing phase, 10 participants were involved, trained in all partner countries, who evaluated the results obtained and helped to make possible changes. Thanks to the testing phase, the development programme, manual and tool-box were validated and finalised, with the aim of verifying the accuracy of the prepared materials and making recommendations. Separately, four local events were organised, one in each partner country, involving over 150 people. During the events, the project and its results were presented. On these occasions, experts were invited to discuss issues related to the LGBTQIA+ world, with a focus on the workplace.





# The last phase of the project has begun

The last phase of the project, which will end at the end of October 2024, has just begun. In September, the partners will participate in a training phase to be held in Palermo, hosted by IRSEI, the project coordinator. On this occasion, the issues addressed during the project will be explored in depth and there will be an opportunity to exchange views with local experts. Moreover, the consortium is already working to ensure the sustainability of the results obtained and to take further steps towards the creation of the new professional role of Pride Network Leader, in order to ensure a lasting impact.
